Seek testing for COVID-19 and report to Compliance and Safety  Instructors will work with you on make-up work, and you should join your in-person classes virtually through WebEx.	STAY HOME!  Seek testing for COVID-19 and report to Compliance and Safety and Employee Health	Stay home for at least 5 days. Day 0 is your first day of symptoms and day 1 is your first full day after symptoms developed.  Return after the 5 full days if fever-free for 24 hours* and symptoms have improved. Masking is required upon return.  If symptoms have not improved, or still have a fever, wait until you are fever-free for 24 hours*  If you have access to testing, it is recommended (but not required) towards the end of your 5 day isolation period.  *without the use of fever reducing medication
Have a COVID positive family member – or have had close contact exposure with someone who is C19 positive?	If you're symptomatic, stay home!  Instructors will work with you on make-up work, and you should join your in-person classes virtually through WebEx.  No restrictions for those	If you're symptomatic, stay home!
